SAFETY, EMERGENCY AND INSURANCE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT



A. Master Record & Document Relationship

- I confirm that my current Community Member Registration & Master Information Form identifies my 2027 campground record and that this form supplements, and does not replace, the current Community Member Licence Agreement and Campground Rules and Policies.

B. Assumption of Inherent Risks

- I understand that camping, outdoor recreation, and use of campground facilities and activities involve inherent and ordinary risks, including changing weather, natural terrain, trees and branches, wildlife and insects, water-related hazards, campfires, vehicles and golf carts, recreational equipment, slips/trips/falls, and the actions of other persons.
- I voluntarily choose to use the campground and participate in activities appropriate to me and persons in my care, and I agree to exercise reasonable care, use required safety equipment, observe posted warnings, and follow reasonable safety directions.
- I understand that this acknowledgement does not remove duties or liabilities that cannot lawfully be excluded or limited.

C. Emergency Trailer Access

- I have provided Campground Management with a current trailer key or another emergency access method specifically approved in writing by Campground Management.
- I authorize use of that access only for emergency, safety, property-protection, utility, or other authorized access reasonably necessary under the Licence Agreement or applicable law. This does not transfer custody of or responsibility for my trailer or contents to the campground.

D. Children, Emergency Assistance and Medical Response

- I remain responsible for the supervision, conduct, safety, and activity-participation decisions of minors in my care, except to the extent expressly assumed by a supervised campground program.
- If urgent medical or emergency assistance reasonably appears necessary, campground staff may contact **911** or other emergency services and take reasonable immediate safety steps. Reasonable efforts will be made to contact a parent/guardian for a minor, but inability to make contact will not prevent an emergency call.
- Except where otherwise required by law, third-party ambulance, medical, transportation, or emergency-service costs remain the responsibility of the person receiving the service or, where applicable, the parent/guardian.

E. Insurance Declaration

- I confirm that I am responsible for maintaining appropriate insurance for my trailer, approved structures, contents, personal property, and liabilities for the period of campground occupancy, as required by the Licence Agreement or Campground Rules and Policies.
- I will provide reasonable evidence of current coverage when required and will notify Campground Management of a lapse or cancellation that affects a mandatory insurance requirement
